Overview of "whole person" women's health using a comprehensive life course framework in the global context to include issues well beyond traditional maternal-child health and reproductive health focus areas.

Research principles and applications for women's health

Practical application of research principles for women's health: research approaches and design, analysis, ethics, related historical legacy of gendered science, cultural competency, for population health and commercial applications.

Leadership for women's health

Leadership principles and style course with personality testing, key components of leadership and components on communication and advocacy. Complemented by personal reflections, peer discussions and fireside chat style sessions with global women leaders
